Background:

BeltLogistics aims at establishing cross-border cooperation between associations and public authorities dealing with the transport and logistics sector including the knowledge and research institutions as well.

The project will particularly look into developing and building up a network between this primary target group and also try to engage logistics companies whenever relevant.

The project’s main focus areas are:

1. Building of a BeltLogistics Network
2. Investigation of a BeltLogistics Cluster

The BeltLogistics Network focus area deals with issues and challenges related to infrastructure development, development of services, capacity building, knowledge sharing and cross-border anchoring among the stakeholders and actors in the project.

Another aim of the project is to analyze the BeltLogistics Cluster through looking at the competitiveness in the region, making of a cluster analysis of the logistics sector in the region, derive and develop future services in the region and finally to promote the region as an attractive place for investment in the logistics sector.

In both focus areas the project partners will initiate and facilitate activities through workshops, seminars, and fact-finding tours with either a narrow or broad audience depending on the specific topic.

The project “BeltLogistics” was initiated by Wirtschaftsförderung Lübeck GmbH and Roskilde University in connection with the development scheme of the “Fehmarnbelt-Region” 2007-2013 through the EU support program INTERREG IVA.
