Background

BeltLogistics aims at establishing cross-border cooperation between associations and public authorities dealing with the transport and logistics sector including the knowledge and research institutions as well.

The Fact-Finding-Tour to Port of Lübeck is an opportunity for German and Danish companies, public authorities and educational institutions to get information about how Port of Lübeck is facing future challenges, what are the major logistics activities and strategic planning in regard to the Fixed Fehmarnbelt Link.
